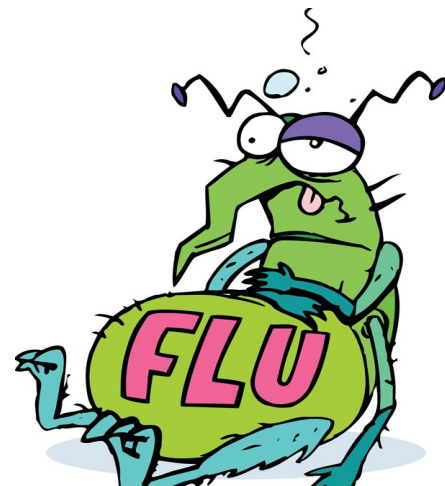


**FINAL 2020 Flu Vaccination Clinics**

**The Quadrivalent flu vaccine is offered to all Staff Members employed with the:**

BCC Government Clerk of Courts  
Supervisors of Elections  
Property Appraiser  
Tax Collector



**Insured Retirees and Insured staff member Spouses must present their Allegiance Card at time of vaccination.**

The quadrivalent vaccine for use in the 2020-2021 influenza season contains the following: an A/Guangdong-Maonan/SWL1536/2019 (H1N1)pdm09-like virus; an A/Hong Kong/2671/2019 (H3N2)-like virus; a B/Washington/02/2019 (B/Victoria lineage)-like virus; and a B/Phuket/3073/2013 (B/Yamagata lineage)-like virus

**FLU VACCINATIONS ARE NOT OFFERED THROUGH OUR MEDCENTERS.**

**A Thimerosal-Free Vaccine is offered at these 2 locations.**

The High Dose Flu Vaccine (recommended for those age 65 and older) is offered by appointment, 566-7676, at Advance Medical of Naples, 720 Goodlette Rd. N. Suite 500, Naples. There is no office co-pay for this service and the vaccination is FREE for those insured with Allegiance.

**Take these everyday steps to protect your health:**

- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread this way.

If you are sick with flu-like illness, **CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone** except to get medical care or for other necessities. (Your fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.) Please follow your agency's sick leave policy or direction specific for this flu season.
