The trivalent vaccine for use in the 2017-2018 influenza season contains the following: an A/Michigan/45/2015 (H1N1) pdm09-like virus; an A/Hong Kong/4801/2014 (H3N2)-like virus; a B/Brisbane/60/2008-like (B/Victoria lineage) virus; B/Phuket/3037/2013-like (B/Yamagata lineage) virus.

PLEASE NOTE: The flu vaccine will not give you the flu.

(Your fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.) Please follow your agency's sick leave policy or direction specific for this flu season.
